

Dear candidate,

As a voter in this year's elections, I am writing to ascertain your position on women's rights.

As you know, there are many council-controlled services that impact specifically on women's and girls' rights, e.g.:-

- Single sex toilets and changing facilities in public spaces, schools and leisure centres
- Single sex sports provision, in schools and recreation

I write to ask how you, as my elected representative, would do that, and I hope I can rely on your support. Should you choose not to respond, I will assume that this is not a priority for you, and I will cast my vote accordingly.
